 **Historic room revenue estimates were based exclusively on the collection of hotel room tax (HRT) by eligible accommodation establishments across BC. This tax was repealed on June 30, 2010 and BC Stats is now basing their room revenues on a smaller, yet more focused, source of additional hotel room tax (AHRT). Since AHRT is only collected in certain municipalities across BC, the remaining room revenues are modelled based on revenue streams from the harmonized sales tax (HST). Until BC Stats has had an opportunity to test the robustness of the modelled figures from non-AHRT collecting vendors, room revenue estimates for July 2010 onward should be considered preliminary and may be subject to larger than usual revisions.
Note to users: The methodology used to generate room revenue estimates is currently being reviewed and refined.
 As a result the regularly scheduled release of the April and May 2011 issues of the TSM was delayed. BC Stats will be publishing updated estimates, including revisions to previously-released data in early July, after which the regular release schedule will resume. We apologize for any inconvenience to users.
